# SHORT DESCRIPTION

The **Model EU Brussels** is the combination of an online intensive course conducted **by the Eastwest European Institute in partnership with Associazione Diplomatici**, and an on-site simulation delivered by **eastwest ONLUS**.

By taking on the role of a member of the Parliament and ministers of the Council of the European Union, are invited to rethink the concept of Europe by proposing and discussing their ideas and solutions to current issues.

The project's main goal is **to make participants learn more about the functioning of the central European institutions thanks to direct experience** of the ordinary EU legislative procedure with the learning-by-doing method, through a three-day-long simulation.
