**WITH JEAN MONNET** 

"Europe will not be made all at once, or according to a single plan. It will be built through concrete achievements which first create a de facto solidarity. Democracy owes its origin and development to Christianity. It was born when man was called to realize the dignity of the person in individual freedom, respect for the rights of others and the love of neighbour. Before Christian message these principles had not been formulated, nor they ever became the spiritual basis of an authority system." (Robert Schuman)

KONRAD ADENAUER "We Europeans must exercise together also foreign policy, only this purpose can really help us."
